



Introduction

Precision is committed to responsible manufacturing and the safety of our products. We strive to comply with all relevant legal and regulatory requirements concerning chemical substances used in our products as well as on the manufacturing practices of our production sites and the ones from our suppliers.

This policy outlines our approach to ensuring compliance and transparency throughout our supply chain.

Legal and Regulatory Requirements

We adhere to a comprehensive set of legal and regulatory requirements related to chemical content in our products. This includes complying with 19 key local and global regulations (listed as Annex 8 - Global Regulatory Compliance List v1.1). We actively monitor changes in these regulations and update our practices accordingly.

Supplier Engagement on Chemical Composition

We partner closely with our suppliers to ensure the responsible use of chemicals in our products. For all our suppliers, we require mandatory reporting on their position regarding legal and regulatory requirements.

Addressing Market Requirements and Customer Requests

In addition to legal and regulatory requirements, we recognize the importance of meeting market expectations and specific customer needs.

- **Market Requirements:** We acknowledge the existence of more than 100 market-driven requirements for chemical element absence (listed on Annex 1). While these are not mandatory, we encourage our suppliers to report their position on them.
- **Customer Requests:** We address specific customer requests for information on the chemical composition of our products. We currently have requests from 8 global customers who require certification and questionnaires to be completed for compliance.

For both market requirements and customer requests, we understand that providing comprehensive information can require time and resources from our suppliers. We work collaboratively with them to obtain this information while allowing them flexibility to respond within a reasonable timeframe.

Transparency and Communication

We are committed to transparency regarding the chemical composition of our products and manufacturing practices of our value chain. We strive to provide accurate and up-to-date information to all stakeholders, including:

- **Public:** We will make this policy publicly available on our website.
- **Customers:** We will work with customers to understand their specific needs and provide them with relevant information regarding the chemical compliance of our products.
- **Suppliers:** We will maintain open communication with our suppliers and provide them with clear guidance on our expectations regarding chemical compliance reporting.
